Privacy Policy

Thank you for visiting https://colospan.com/ (together with all content on the website and other websites operated by Colospan, Ltd. or its affiliates ("Colospan") (the "Site")). Your privacy is important to us. To better protect your privacy, we provide this privacy policy ("Privacy Policy") explaining our online information practices and the choices you can make about the way your information is collected and used at this Site. This Privacy Policy form is part of the Terms of Use, available at https://colospan.com/.

Introduction

We are committed to respecting your online privacy and recognize your need for appropriate protection and management of any personal data you share with us.

"Personal Data" means any information that may be used to identify an individual, either directly or indirectly, including, but not limited to, a first and last name, pen name, personal profile, a home or other physical address and an email address or other contact information.

We do not require you to provide personal data in order to have access to information available on our Site. Your personal data will be collected only if you provide your personal data when you communicate with us. If you are a visitor from the EU you will not have access to the online clinical study application questionnaire. This questionnaire is intended only for US visitors.

The Way We Use Personal Information

If you submit personal data to us through the Site, then we will use your personal data to improve our services to you, to contact you in case you submit a request for information and to identify and authenticate your access to the Site's services that you are authorized to access.

We may transfer your personal data within Colospan or to Colospan's third-party service providers, but only to provide services on the Site or to you, across borders, and from your country or jurisdiction to Israel, where Colospan is established. Israel has been recognized by the European Commission as a country providing an adequate level of data protection.

In addition, Colospan works with vendors located in the US. Any personal data submitted through the Site will be also stored and processed in the US. Your personal data will, therefore, be transferred to the US. Finally, we may process your personal data on other legal bases, e.g. i) if this is necessary to comply with any applicable law, regulation, legal process or governmental request to which we are subject, ii) if the processing is necessary in order to protect your or another natural person's vital interests; or iii) if the processing is necessary for the purposes of Colospan legitimate interests.

Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies

Some of our Site pages utilize "cookies" and other tracking technologies. A "cookie" is a small text file that may be used, for example, to collect information about Site activity. Some cookies and other technologies may serve to recall personal data previously indicated by a Site user. Most browsers allow you to control cookies, including whether or not to accept them and how to remove them.
